Annual Report 2021-22 on CSR Activities Implemented with the Support of GMR Pochanpalli Expressways Limited (GPEL)

The CSR fund from GPEL has been spent for various social developments initiatives in the villages across the highway stretch of GPEL and GMR Hyderabad-Vijayawada Express-Way. The details of these activities and the related expenditure are given below.

Pochanpalli Expressway Region

Education Activities

Expenditure: Rs. 400013 /-

- Supported 8 Govt. schools for academic, extra-curricular activities, sensitization programs and celebration of important days of significance.
- Provided Teaching and Learning Material to associated Govt. Schools.
- 100% pass out rate for high school students where tuitions are being conducted.
- Specialized GMRVF workbooks distributed to 500 primary school students.
- Provided study material for NMMS (National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship) and NTSE (National Talent Search Examination) to students of Std. VIII and X – 12 students got selected for NMMS
- Distributed study material to students of Std. X in 3 associated Govt. Schools.
- 12 students got selected for NMMS a total scholarship worth Rs. 5.76 lakhs.
- The community library running with the support of Nature Icon Youth at Kucharam village, Medak district is benefitting about 400 users every month. The library contains books suitable for all age groups and sections of the community.





Community Development, Empowerment & Road Safety Activities

Expenditure: 181628 /-

- Conducted 143 Road Safety awareness programs for different target groups covering over 24000 individuals during the financial year 2021-2022.
- Developed tailor-made media tools such as road safety week leaflets, user specific pamphlets, banners, videos, etc. to be used for different target groups.
- Observed 51st National Safety day 2022 and reached out to over 200 school children.
- Organized Joint road safety programs with Police, TSRTC (Telangana State Road Transport Corporation) and Road Transport Office authorities at highway adjacent villages.
- Organized Essay, Drawing and Elocution competitions on Road Safety to school and college students.
- Organized Road safety awareness program and a campaign on the consequences of drunk and drive with the support of Police Department.
- Supported youth in celebrating various events and involved them in different activities.
- Observed World Environment Day, International Women's Day and Swachhta Pakhwada in Highway stretch villages.
- Cricket kits were distributed to youth in 3 villages. Around 80 youth benefitted from the program.
- Employment was arranged to 3 unemployed youth as Fastag promoters with the salary of Rs.
 16,000 per month.
- GMRVF took part in a special meal drive organized by Abhisiti Foundation, Hyderabad and arranged dinner for about 650 orphans and elderly people in 6 orphan and old age homes.





Healthcare & COVID Relief Activities:

Expenditure: 97001 /-

- Organized 6 medical and eye camps benefitting 896 drivers, laborers, road users and individuals from deprived communities in the villages adjacent to the Highway.
- Organized 85 health awareness programs and sensitized 14736 villagers, road users and school students on different health aspects.
- Organized Swachhata Pakhwada program benefiting over 1000 people.
- Celebrated World Breastfeeding Week, Poshan Abhiyann and National Nutrition Week benefitting about 300 pregnant and lactating women.
- Distributed around 80 Aids and Appliance to specially abled persons with the support of NILD (National Institute of Locomotor Disabilities), Kolkata.
- Conducted awareness on Covid-19 and safe hand washing at Govt. Schools and sensitized about 300 students during the program.
- Conducted awareness campaign on COVID 19 at Toll Plaza and major junctions along the Highway stretch. 10325 road users and others were sensitized in these programs.
- Around 2500 masks were distributed to road users, laborers, roadside vendors, students and others.





Hyderabad-Vijayawada Expressway Region

 RO Water Purifiers, Sports and Science Lab Material and provided need based infra support benefiting 2000 students
- Almira, Computers, Mike set, Supported Sanitary Pads, to ZPHS Katanguru School Students.
- Support for National Festivals and Special days at Govt. School's reaching out to 600 Students.
- Distribution of study material to 165 students for preparation of examinations related to State Gurukul schools, National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship etc.

- Free Drinking water supply was setup at Korlapahad, Panthangi, and Chilakallu Toll plazas in summer.
